## **SALE TERMS & CONDITIONS**

1. Sale order will follow catalogue order.
2. Northlands currently offers an incentive program for the Bloodstock Sale during Farmfair International. If a horse being sold at the Bloodstock Sale meets the criteria (3 years old or younger) and goes through the sale (they can be passed if they do not reach their reserve bid but must go through the sale ring), they can return as 4 & 5 year olds at the Canadian National Team Roping Futurity and Northlands Barrel Racing Futurity at Farmfair and be eligible to split \$10,000 among all of the returning eligible horses. The incentive is on the horse so it will transfer along with the horse, regardless of how many times the ownership changes during the eligible years. They do not have to win their respective competitions but must not be disqualified in order to be a part of the split. As well, if tested for drugs and residue of prohibited substances are found, they would not be eligible.
3. Northlands does not act as agent for either the seller or buyer, but merely provides an environment in order to permit the binding together of an agreement between seller and buyer for the purpose of sale/purchase transactions. Any and all representations concerning the horses presented are those of the seller, and no action shall lie against Northlands related to or arising by reason of such representation.
4. The horses are offered for sale according to the laws of the Provinces of Alberta.
5. Northlands does not offer guarantees of any kind as to the soundness or condition or other of the horses offered. Right of recourse must be directly to the seller, and not through Northlands. All horses will be subject to a presale health exam done by a licensed veterinarian. All results will be available for viewing at the preview and sale.
6. Every effort has been made to ascertain correct information, and to print the same in the Sale Catalogue, however Northlands and auctioneer neither assumes nor accepts responsibility for errors, omissions, or misstatements in the Sale Catalogue. Announcements at the time of auction will take precedence over material contained in the catalogue.
7. The auction sale is "an auction with reserve", that is, the owner shall have the right to establish a reserve bid on their horse a price under which the horse will not be sold. The reserve bid, if any, must be placed in a sealed envelope and presented to the auctioneer prior to the start of the auction sale.
8. The highest bidder in each sale shall be the buyer. The auctioneer's decision on any sale is final. In the case of a dispute between two (2) or more bidders, the auctioneer will resolve this dispute, by where as the auctioneer will re-open the sale of that horse between the bidders in dispute where they can advance the bid. If no advance bid is given, the horse shall go to the person whom the auctioneer recognized as having the last bid. The decision of the auctioneer is final. The auctioneer reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
9. As each lot is sold, an "Agreement of Purchase" will be handed to the buyer for signature. The animal becomes property of the buyer upon signing this "Agreement of Purchase" and the buyer assumes all risk, expense and responsibility of the horse from this time hence. The buyer must sign this and also indicate how the animal is to be transferred.
10. The seller warrants that his horse is free from any encumbrances whatsoever.
11. All sales are final and there will be no recourse of any kind following the sale.
12. Terms of Sale are cash and payment in full must be made to the cashier immediately after the Sale. We will accept VISA, MasterCard, debit transactions, cash, bank draft or valid personal cheques, with proper identification.
13. GST will be charged on the selling price.
14. Notwithstanding, once payment of the horse has been received, the horse will be released to the buyer. For registered horses: Northlands will retain all registration papers, transfer reports and any other pertinent documents related to the horse purchased. When the payment clears, the papers, along with the signed transfer certificate, will be mailed to the buyer.
15. Transfer of ownership is the sole responsibility of the purchaser. Delivery is the responsibility of the buyer.
16. The animal must be removed from Hall A of the Edmonton EXPO Centre by 10 p.m. on Friday, November 10, 2017
17. If the animal is kept overnight on the Northlands location, contact information for the animal must be supplied and if kept in a stall a stall cost will be charged.
18. Insurance is the responsibility of the new owner effective on all horses upon the auctioneer declaring the horse sold.
19. Any person attending the Sale does so at his/her own risk, and recognizes that there are inherent dangers. Northlands and consignors assume no liability, legal or otherwise, for any accident that may occur.

## **SALE TERMS & CONDITIONS**

1. Sale order will follow catalogue order.
2. Northlands currently offers an incentive program for the Bloodstock Sale during Farmfair International. If a horse being sold at the Bloodstock Sale meets the criteria (3 years old or younger) and goes through the sale (they can be passed if they do not reach their reserve bid but must go through the sale ring), they can return as 4 & 5 year olds at the Canadian National Team Roping Futurity and Northlands Barrel Racing Futurity at Farmfair and be eligible to split \$10,000 among all of the returning eligible horses. The incentive is on the horse so it will transfer along with the horse, regardless of how many times the ownership changes during the eligible years. They do not have to win their respective competitions but must not be disqualified in order to be a part of the split. As well, if tested for drugs and residue of prohibited substances are found, they would not be eligible.
3. Northlands does not act as agent for either the seller or buyer, but merely provides an environment in order to permit the binding together of an agreement between seller and buyer for the purpose of sale/purchase transactions. Any and all representations concerning the horses presented are those of the seller, and no action shall lie against Northlands related to or arising by reason of such representation.
4. The horses are offered for sale according to the laws of the Provinces of Alberta.
5. Northlands does not offer guarantees of any kind as to the soundness or condition or other of the horses offered. Right of recourse must be directly to the seller, and not through Northlands. All horses will be subject to a presale health exam done by a licensed veterinarian. All results will be available for viewing at the preview and sale.
6. Every effort has been made to ascertain correct information, and to print the same in the Sale Catalogue, however Northlands and auctioneer neither assumes nor accepts responsibility for errors, omissions, or misstatements in the Sale Catalogue. Announcements at the time of auction will take precedence over material contained in the catalogue.
7. The auction sale is "an auction with reserve", that is, the owner shall have the right to establish a reserve bid on their horse a price under which the horse will not be sold. The reserve bid, if any, must be placed in a sealed envelope and presented to the auctioneer prior to the start of the auction sale.
8. The highest bidder in each sale shall be the buyer. The auctioneer's decision on any sale is final. In the case of a dispute between two (2) or more bidders, the auctioneer will resolve this dispute, by where as the auctioneer will re-open the sale of that horse between the bidders in dispute where they can advance the bid. If no advance bid is given, the horse shall go to the person whom the auctioneer recognized as having the last bid. The decision of the auctioneer is final. The auctioneer reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
9. As each lot is sold, an "Agreement of Purchase" will be handed to the buyer for signature. The animal becomes property of the buyer upon signing this "Agreement of Purchase" and the buyer assumes all risk, expense and responsibility of the horse from this time hence. The buyer must sign this and also indicate how the animal is to be transferred.
10. The seller warrants that his horse is free from any encumbrances whatsoever.
11. All sales are final and there will be no recourse of any kind following the sale.
12. Terms of Sale are cash and payment in full must be made to the cashier immediately after the Sale. We will accept VISA, MasterCard, debit transactions, cash, bank draft or valid personal cheques, with proper identification.
13. GST will be charged on the selling price.
14. Notwithstanding, once payment of the horse has been received, the horse will be released to the buyer. For registered horses: Northlands will retain all registration papers, transfer reports and any other pertinent documents related to the horse purchased. When the payment clears, the papers, along with the signed transfer certificate, will be mailed to the buyer.
15. Transfer of ownership is the sole responsibility of the purchaser. Delivery is the responsibility of the buyer.
16. The animal must be removed from Hall A of the Edmonton EXPO Centre by 10 p.m. on Friday, November 10, 2017
17. If the animal is kept overnight on the Northlands location, contact information for the animal must be supplied and if kept in a stall a stall cost will be charged.
18. Insurance is the responsibility of the new owner effective on all horses upon the auctioneer declaring the horse sold.
19. Any person attending the Sale does so at his/her own risk, and recognizes that there are inherent dangers. Northlands and consignors assume no liability, legal or otherwise, for any accident that may occur.

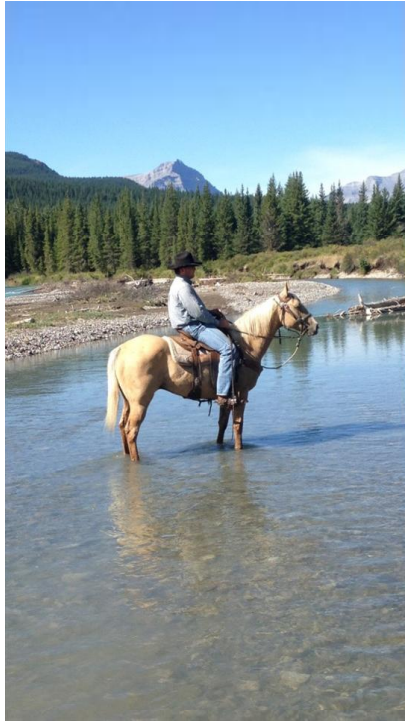
