## **Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement**

Participant's or Attendee's Name: Waiver: In consideration of being permitted to participate or attend Premier Livestock Activities, I, for myself, my heirs, personal representatives or assigns, do hereby release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue Premier Livestock, its officers, employees, and agents (the "Released Parties") from liability from any and all claims including the negligence of Premier Livestock its officers, employees, volunteers and agents, resulting in personal injury, accidents or illnesses (including death), and property loss arising from, but not limited to, participation in Premier Livestock Activities.

Assumption of Risks: Participation in Premier Livestock Activities carries with it certain inherent risks that cannot be eliminated regardless of the care taken to avoid injuries. The specific risks vary from one activity to another, but the risks range from 1) minor injuries such as scratches, bruises, and sprains; 2) major injuries such as eye injury or loss of sight, joint or back injuries, heart attacks, and concussions; and 3) catastrophic injuries including paralysis and death.

COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. As a result, health agencies recommend social distancing and have, in many locations, prohibited the congregation of groups over certain size limits. By attending or participating in this event, you might increase the risk that you or your family members might contract COVID-19. You acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that you or your family members may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 through participation in this event and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death.

You agree to abide by all facility, city, county, and provincial requirements or recommendations related to COVID-19 protection measures and understand and agree that you may be required to leave the facility and be disqualified from the event if you fail to abide by COVID19 protection measures as instructed.

I have read the previous paragraphs and I know, understand, and appreciate these and other risks that are inherent in Premier Livestock Activities. I hereby assert that my participation is voluntary and that I knowingly assume all such risks.

Indemnification and Hold Harmless: I also agree to INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS the Released Parties from any and all claims, actions, suits, procedures, costs, expenses, damages and liabilities, including attorney's fees brought as a result of my involvement in Premier Livestock Activities, and to reimburse them for any such expenses incurred. I understand and agree that this release includes any Claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of the Released Parties, including any Claim arising from a COVID-19 infection occurring before, during, or after participation in any Premier Livestock Activity.

Severability: The show is on a private property and the property owner assumes no risk, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect. Acknowledgment of Understanding: I have read this Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement, fully understand its terms, and understand that I am giving up substantial rights, including my right to sue. I acknowledge that I am signing the agreement freely and voluntarily, and intend by my signature to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law.
