The buyers will have the option of having the animal butchered at Love Custom Meats in Vegreville on June 16, 2022.

The Goodridge 4H Club will be having their annual BBQ at the Goodridge Hall on June 18, 2022 @ 6PM. There will be a silent auction as well. Individual \$15.00, Couple \$25.00, Family \$35.00.

### 4-H Beef: *Did you know?*

A **1300 LB** animal will yield approximately 62% carcass weight, which is further processed to equal **580 LBS** of take-home beef.



Cost of beef at grocery store\*:

Ground beef & stew meat: 160 LB @ \$8.39/LB = \$1342

Roasts & steaks: 420 LB @ \$12.30/LB = \$5166

**TOTAL cost at grocery store = \$6508**



\*Based on 2022 grocery store prices & estimated average 4-H sale price

Cost of local 4-H steer\*:

\$3/LB x 1300 LB = \$3900

Cutting & wrapping = \$900

**TOTAL cost of 4-H steer = \$4800**

By purchasing a 4-H steer, you can fill your freezer with premium beef for **\$1708 LESS** than the grocery store, while also supporting local **4-H members** and local butchers!
