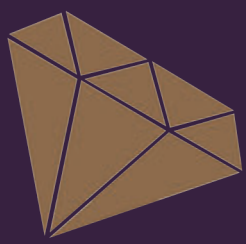

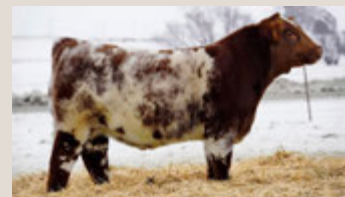

Herbourne Shorthorns



H. W. Acheson and his wife Emily (nee Bourns) were married in 1930. The tattoo letters AHWA were registered to H.W. Acheson & Sons in 1958. Following the deaths of both Herb and Emily in 1975 the herd was transferred to their son on the farm. Bill became the registered owner in 1976 of the herd name and tattoo. The tattoo was changed to HWA for 2010 and on.

The present family are Bill and Isabel on the farm, now 52 years married. Their son, Robert (1975 - 2002), their daughters Teresa in Whitehorse since 1999 and currently President of Yukon Federation of Labour; and Sheri in Fort McMurray since 2004 as a Materials Engineer with Syncrude and married since October 2020 to Rob MacNeil. Both girls have given generously of their time and resources to help at shows and to keep the farm going.

The farm had been using purebred Shorthorn bulls for many years. Beginning in the 1960's, A.I. was used considerably. Home-raised bulls were used as early as 1980. Except for one bull for the Shorthorn International Bull Sale in February of 1974, our cattle show ventures began in 1980. We have also been contributors to the Manitoba Test Stations.

In recent years the herd has been 15-20 breeding cows. 2025 has been a year of herd reductions: heifer calves (private sales), bred cows (herd package), replacement heifers (test station sale) and now our first appearance in the Jewels of the Prairie Sale with 5 head specially selected for this occasion. We will be feeding 3 April & May heifer calves for sale next spring.

Over the years we have always stressed growth and performance. We have strived to keep the herd purebred Shorthorn, free of outcross blood lines. All the entries are halter broke. The prime young cows selling bred were pregnancy checked by Ultrasound and breeding dates confirmed. Remember one has a chance to purchase Shorthorns of this quality only when the breeder is selling the herd.

We end with a special Thank You to Steppler Farms, Miami, MB for their purchase of the herd package of bred females (2 are embryo recipients) all 100% Shorthorn. As well, their juniors purchased 2 heifer calves.

If you are looking for Shorthorn Genetics, this is a must to put on your calendar, and even if you are only remotely interested in any way, please accept this as our invitation to come and join us at the sale event and enjoy the social atmosphere with Shorthorn breeders.



This is the calf that caused so much excitement and interest at our display at the Manitoba Test Station for the World Shorthorn Conference Tour visit July 13. Together with her dam they were named Grand Champion Female. She has always been my favourite heifer calf for this year.

The cow, Ruby's Lily 3L, was shown as a calf, and as a bred heifer. At AG EX 24 she was in the winning Progeny of Dam and Get of Sire groups. She was preg tested positive for an early Feb/26 calf that should match her A.I. breeding date of May 3 to Herbourne Bundy 23P, a bull we raised from Victor Gislason's cow Dawnvue Tilley Taylor, and Sutherland Bundaberg from the Kentucky herd of John & David Ragsdale. Exposed May 5, 2025 to Balmoral Oaks Kinetic Energy from then on.

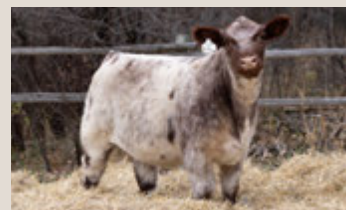

Uphill Shorthorns

Uphill Shorthorns is a 3rd generation herd which originated when my grandfather bought cattle that had been brought in from Britain to be sold for flood relief in Winnipeg in the late 1940's to 50's. I began building my herd in 1997 when I moved to the farm and have added genetics over the years from various herds. Herd bulls have been purchased in Canada and the United States and AI sires used as well. We strive for optimum performance without sacrificing body depth and thickness. The females need to be feminine and productive with strong feet and udders to remain in the herd. We try to maintain calving ease but don't push the envelope too hard and lose all of the performance. 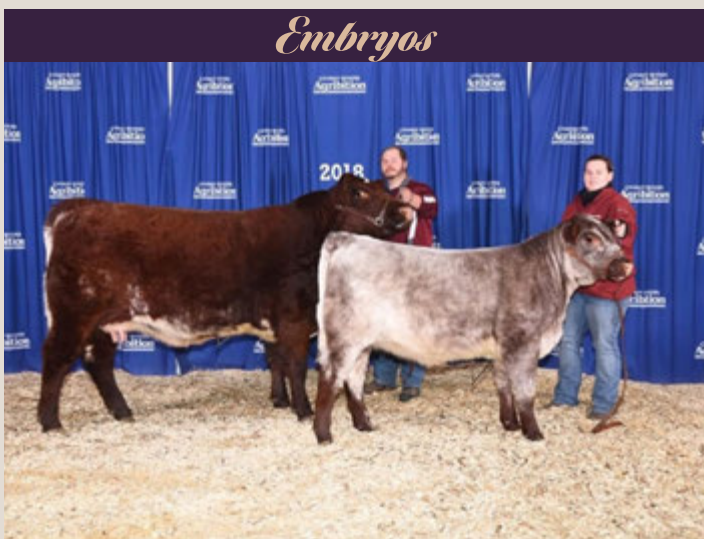

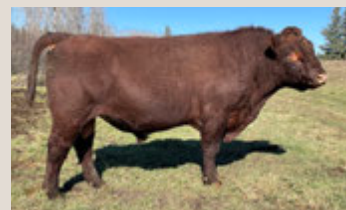

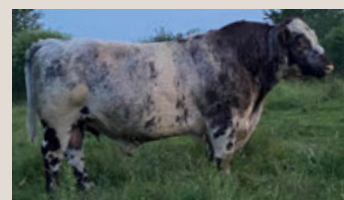
