All announcements made from the auction block will take precedence over the printed material in the catalogue. Buyers are advised to pay close attention.

INSURANCE:


Will be available on sale day. We strongly recommend that insurance is purchased for full value.



He is as hairy as you can make them and as quiet as they come. The potential is endless for this calf. We are very excited to see where this year will take him.



Here I Am cranked out both Champions at the Calgary Stampede this year, and this Here I Am steer continues to impress us each day. He comes out of one of our ultimate favorite commercial Simmy cows 145B. She is an Earley Livestock cow that has had almost every calf she has produced grace the November Gold Sale ring. We are hoping for a heifer before her career of a herd matron comes to an end! Donnie has that show steer look- huge fuzzy ears, big stout hip, big top and a tremendous hair coat. We feel Donnie has as much potential as any steer we have ever offered through this sale ring. Have a look here- this guy has all the right pieces.




Rifled around deep in the AI tank this year and pulled out one of the original orange bulls- Orange Crush. He can still do it. Cheese is just a good honest steer. Really is hard to poke a hole in this guy He is stout, big topped, long bodied and big boned with a huge foot under him. He is so very quiet and would be great for any age. Good haired and nice headed- we think Cheese has endless potential.



Another one to prove that old clubby genetics can still get it done. Walks Alone will always be one of our favorite sires to use. He has yet to disappoint us. Cheeto is stout- big hipped, soft middled, big topped, good haired and can move. He likes to eat and we think he will feed out well to be competitive. His cherry red color and big fuzzy ears will be sure to get you noticed!



Gator is out of a big maine cow we purchased from Pick Six cattle. This cross just clicked for us. This I Am Here steer has impressed us since he was a baby. He is so good natured, making him a dream to work on. He is very long bodied and profiles very nice. We really admire his front 1/3, with a nice smooth shoulder and great neck extension. He has an awesome hair coat and will be a fun one to show!



Good old Tom Selleck can still get it done. We love the feedablilty and temperaments of our Tom calves. They love to eat, grow well, and make the best buddies. Elvis is a steer that we really admire his natural muscle pattern and overall look. He has a really nice front end and is huge hipped. He is good natured and we think this guy will feed easy and make someone a great 4H steer.



Jim Bob is a full brother to Cacey Toner's Kerrobert Regional Champion Steer last year. We think Jim Bob has just as much potential as his brother. This guy just continues to impress us each day. He is good hipped, soft middled and has a rocket front end. He can get out and travel really well. We think he will feed well like his brother before him- Cache tipped the scale at 1500 lbs by mid June. If you are looking for a great 4H steer with some extra added look- Jim Bob is your guy.



Another Grizz calf here. This guy is super docile and would make a great project for all ages. He is big bellied, good hipped and has a really nice front end, to make a striking package. Simmy/Maine is our favorite cross for a reason- good growth with some extra style and flair. Spudnut has a great color and a great hair coat to top it all off. He will make a fun Junior project.



514 a soft made, big-outlined steer, with an easy feeding look. 514 has the typical shape and muscle that the How Great Thou Art cattle are know for. 514 packs that all in with an expressive complete body type!



505 is good looking steer; expressive in his muscle design while still maintaining a sleek look. 505 has the typical IGWT characteristics in a bigger framed package. 505 is soft haired and easy feeding.



Stout featured, big haired with tons of look and body. 541 is a been a standout since he was born and its not just because he's a brockle face. 541 structure and soundness are impeccable; he is one that has tons of future.



537 is massive in every way! Super, bold sprung, awesome turn to his rib cage with added natural muscle. 537 is another How Great Thou Art and this sire group stacked. 537 has that fat steer appearance and we can't wait to see what this guy does!



558 is a steer that has a big-time future! 558 sports that cool Blue Roan coat but still has the muscle shape, bone and presence that we look for. 558 is one that we feel has the potential to be ultra competitive in all stages of development.



Stout, hairy, and an absolute eye catcher! 5104 is a cool marked calf; he is still very juvenile in his appearance, but his future is big time!! 5104 is a steer to really take a good look at.



Calf out of the legendary Wynne In Doubt bull and one of my most consistent cows. Big-hipped, wide-topped, sound, and packed with hair. Big foot, built right.

Want to stand out from the black steers? This white steer is your ticket. Out of a proven IGWT cow and a PB Char bull. Square, wide-based, muscled, and hairy.



Genetics to be a contender next summer. Quiet, hairy, and square-made. Perfect for first-year members or seasoned showmen. Dam has raised multiple champions.



Big, powerful, and stylish. Tan steer with a ton of top and a big hip. He'll turn heads. Not as hairy, but when you're this good, you don't need it.



Lolitta knocked it out of the park again! This is the natural calf and only direct offspring available this year off of our tried and true donor cow. A full sib was purchased by Keylen Eaton at last years sale and was campaigned successfully making many miles around the country. When we compare him to the maternal sibs in the past, this one boosts a little extra rib shape and a touch softer middled. Yet keeping the same look and wicked hair as we've come to expect. He was part of our summer show string being Reserve Steer at Weldon as well as 3rd overall at PAFX.



There is greatness bred into this one. A May We All off a first calf heifer whom just happens to be a full sib to the 2021 Calgary Champion Steer. If she continues to produce ones like this she will undoubtedly fast track herself to the donor pen. This is one we've liked all summer and is easy to find with his "look at me" attitude. Truly, a versatile type steer that will be highly competitive at the spring jackpots yet be manageable to campaign late into the summer.



When I first laid eyes on this calf while down in Alameda on a calf tour, I knew I had to get ahold of him for the sale. Since then has exceeded my expectations. An end of March calf that has about as much body and mass as any other in the offering. We think this guy could be big time and a serious contender next summer.



For any younger or first time showman that wants to have a competitive edge have a look here. This one has been an absolute treat to work on and is calm as a cucumber. Aside from his great disposition we feel he has a little added look, is nicely structured to be serious at some jackpot shows, while also displaying some ruggedness and power to be a contender at a finished beef 4H show.



We really like what his guy has to offer. Despite his young age he's got tons of mass, squareness up high, and stands square and rugged on the ground. Super necked and excellent skeleton. Being as young as he is, it's without a doubt he'll be one to remain fresh and ready to be campaigned later in the season.



Since weaning this one has really poured it on and shows huge potential to continue on that trend. He offers lots of rib, a nice square hip and overall width, and stands on an ideal leg structure. We are confident he's got the right parts to grow up and be competitive. This would be a full ET brother to the 2025 Weyburn 4H Regional Champion Steer for the Fladeland family.



Compared to his pen mates this guy hits the hardest on the profile. He's attractive fronted and proud with tons of style. Body wise, he's extra loose hided and will make a nice manageable feeding type steer. Lots of hair and a calm demeanour makes an excellent choice for a young or first time showman that wants a little extra hair to play with.



High angus influence makes for a sure shot feeding steer with a little extra size and softness. An early March calf that already stands on his own in terms of maturity and do-ability. A maternal sib was sold to Addison Barnett and with a quick social media search one can see just how well that guy turned out for her. We think this one has a lot of similarities and could very well walk the same path with good management.

We feel this is just the start for Mango. She is stout, hairy, sound, good fronted and great tempered. Out of a Timberwagon daughter with a beautiful udder, there is no doubt in our mind that she will make a cow when her show career is over. We have been using the GENEX calving ease bull Bold Ruler for a couple years and we really like his calves. They come easy and have a lot of grow. Jack retained Mango's full sister into his herd last year, so he made the tough decision to offer this gal up for sale.



REGISTERED PUREBRED SIMMENTAL. We think Sweet Dreams is going to make a beautiful bred heifer. She has a beautiful head and neck, a swoopy belly, great hair, all rolled into a fresh and feminine package. We definitely feel her best days are ahead of her as she continues to change and impress us each day. She goes back to the old Simmental herd matron herself- Muirhead's Timberland 7A on her Dam's side, being a direct ET daughter out of SFI Savage. Sweet Dreams is a cookie cutter image of her Dam, and we feel she can go on to the show ring and then head out to pasture and crank out some good ones herself.



REGISTERED ½ SIMMENTAL. This little late February girl is just a damn sweetheart! She has been a pet since day one and would make the perfect heifer if you have a Junior member that needs a quiet first calf! Her Dam Rosie 134B is no stranger to November Gold. She has seen countless steers and heifers go through this ring. Out of our young Simmy herdsire purchased from Twisted Sisters, we think this little half blood heifer can show in the ring and then go on to produce just like her mama. She is made nice with a great head and front end. She has tons of rib shape, she is sound and hairy. Rosie will be a fun one. We will be sad to see this friendly little gal go.




