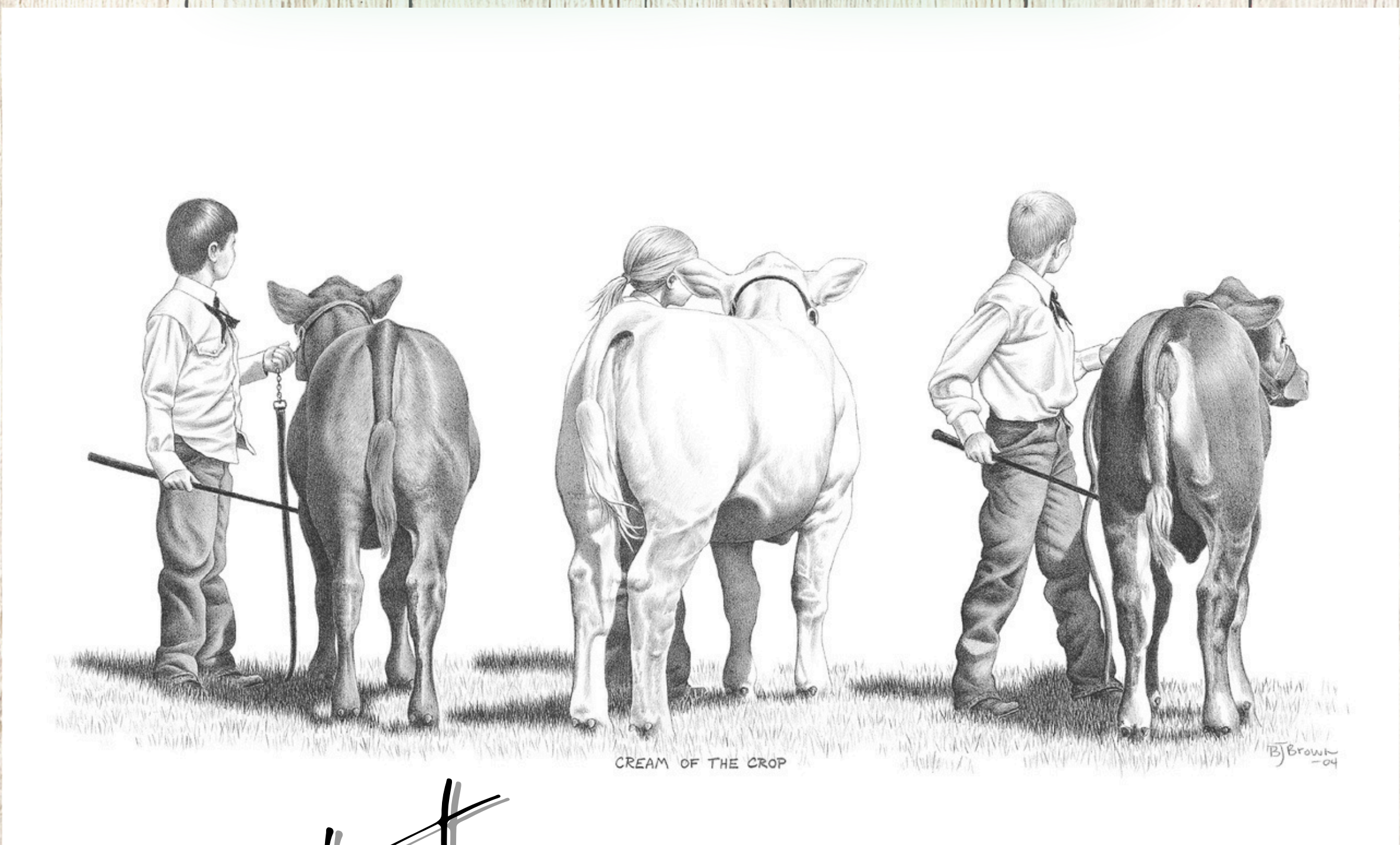

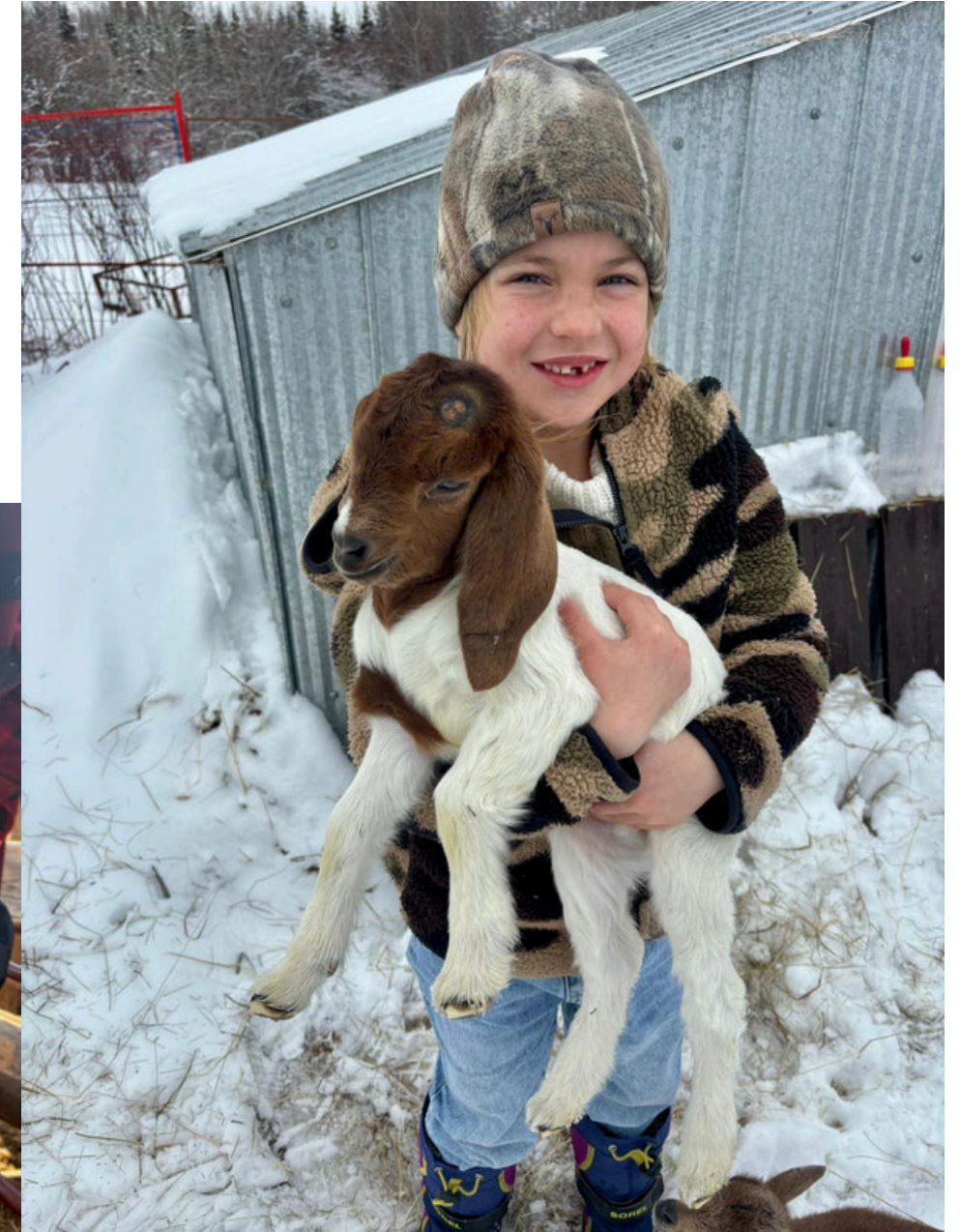

S.W. - 776 LBS

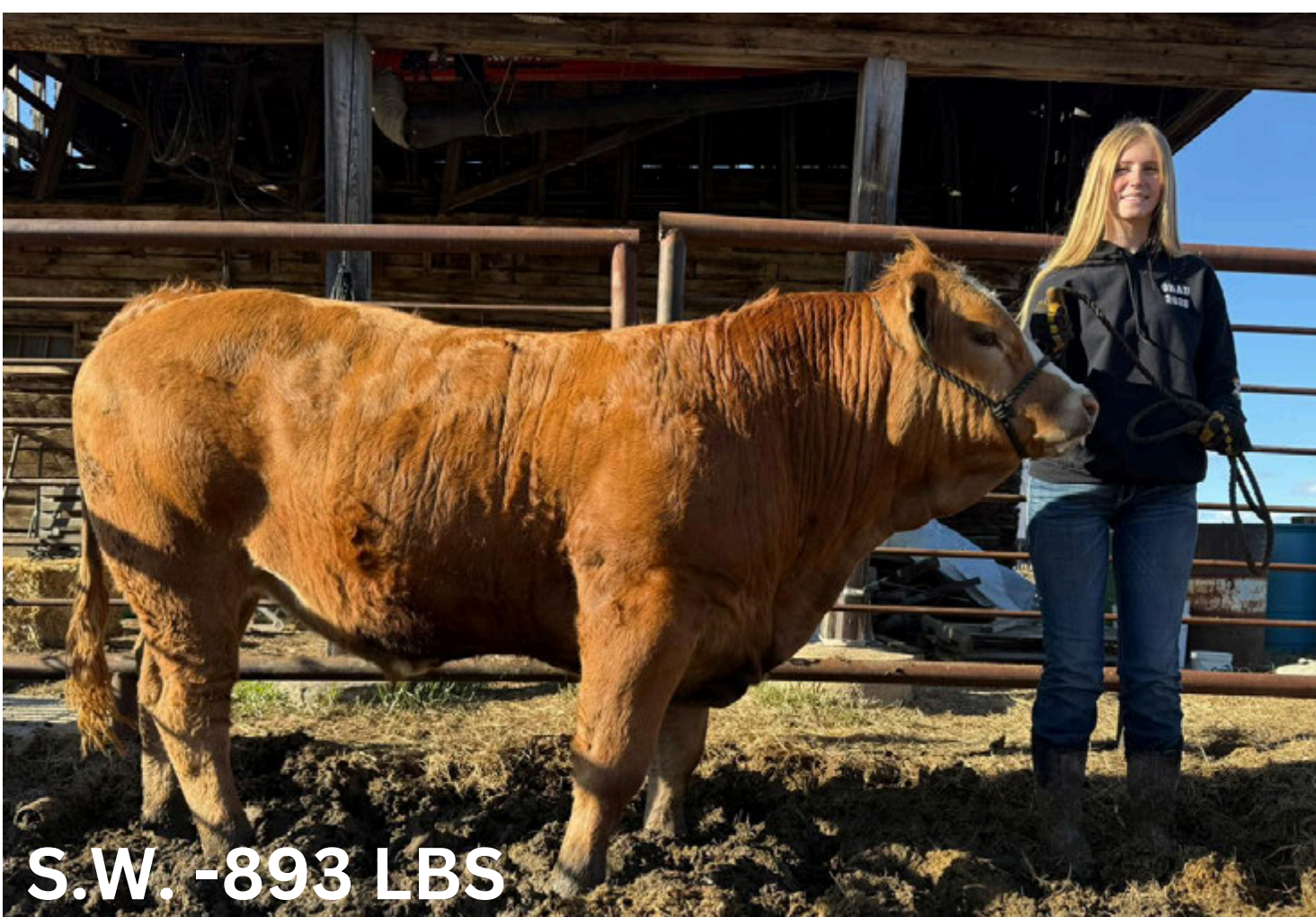
I am a Junior Member and this is my 3rd year in 4-H. My project this year is a Market Steer named Manny.

S.W. - 834 LBS

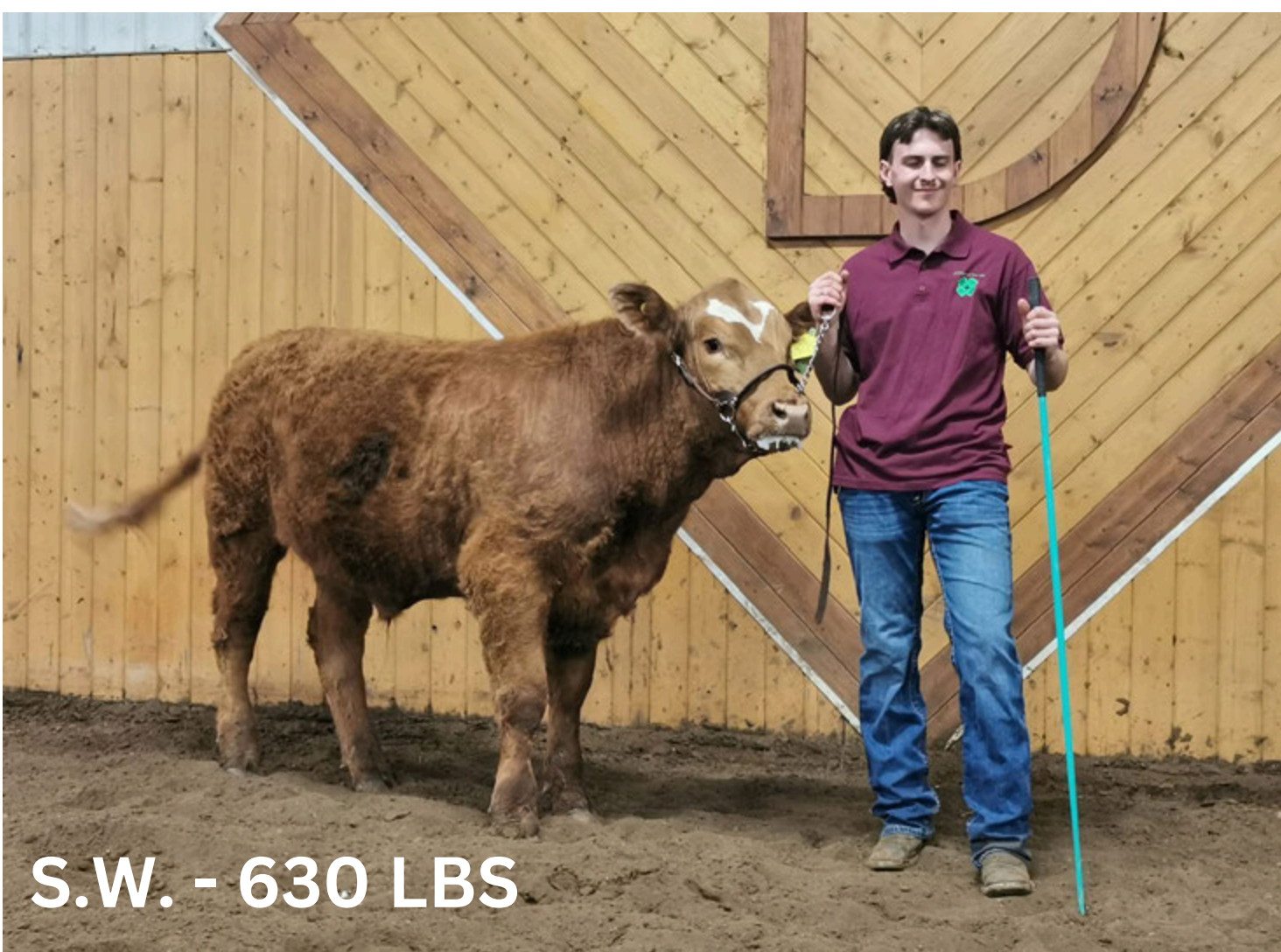
I am a Senior Member and this is my 6th year in 4-H. My project this year is a Market Steer.

I am a Senior Member and this is my 7th year in 4-H. My projects this year are Market Steer, Cow Calf Pair, and Breeding Heifer.

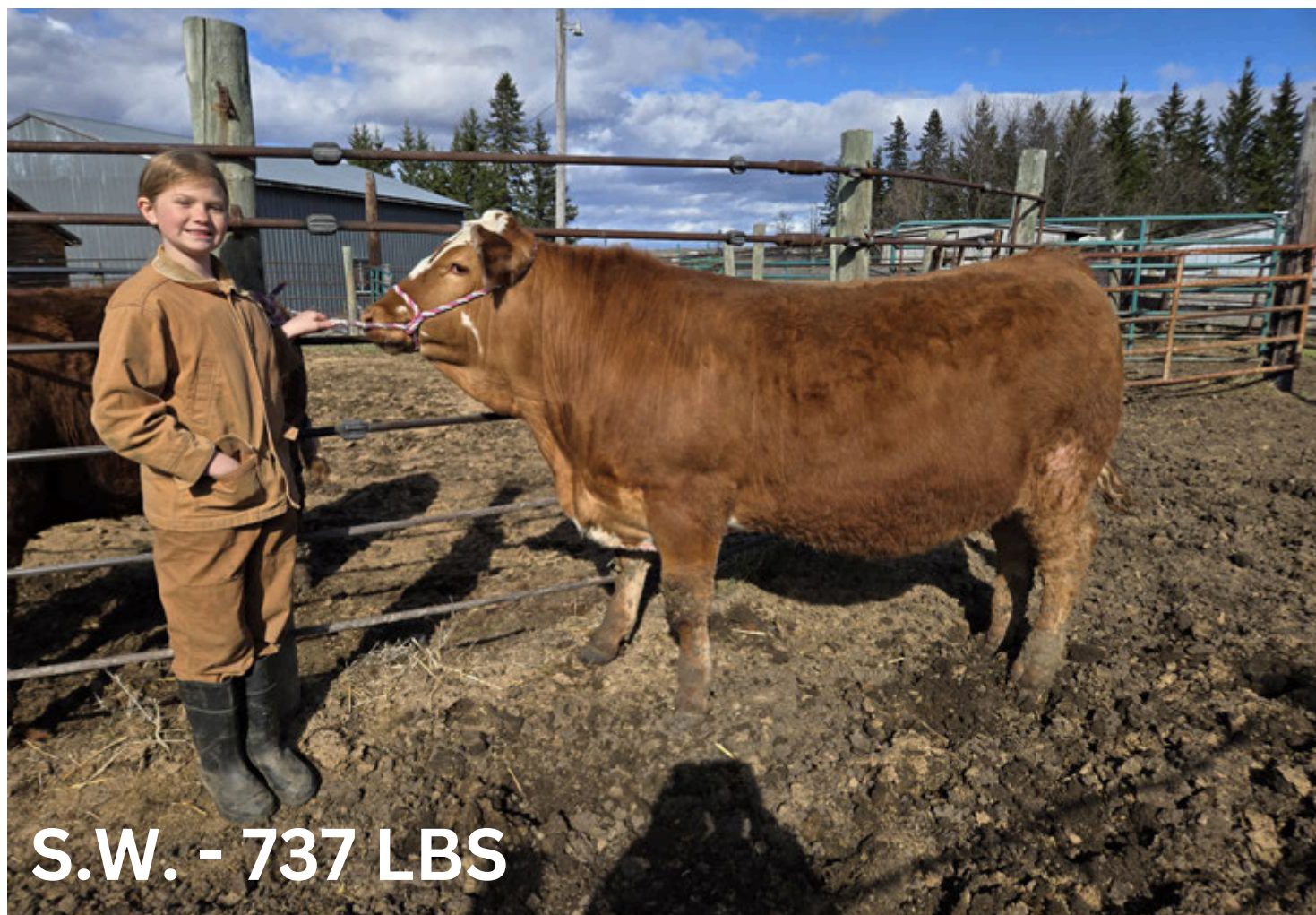
Interests: Farming, Riding Horses, and Snowmobiling.

HENRY FARRELL - ATHABASCA



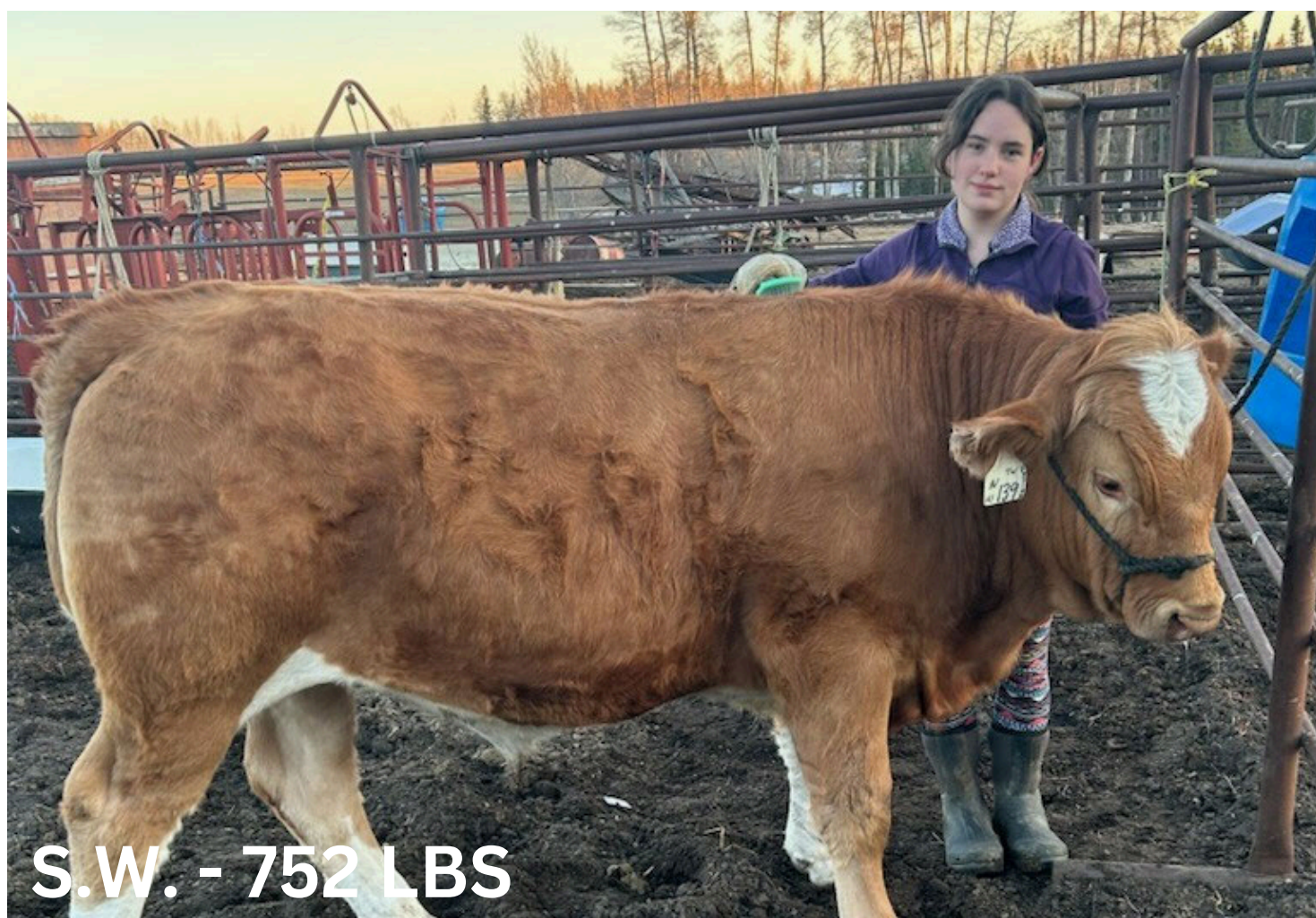
I am a Junior Member and this is my 2nd year in 4-H. My projects this year are Market Steer and Breeding Heifer.

I am a Senior Member and this is my 7th year in 4-H. My Projects this year are Market Steer, Breeding Heifer, and Cow Calf Pair.

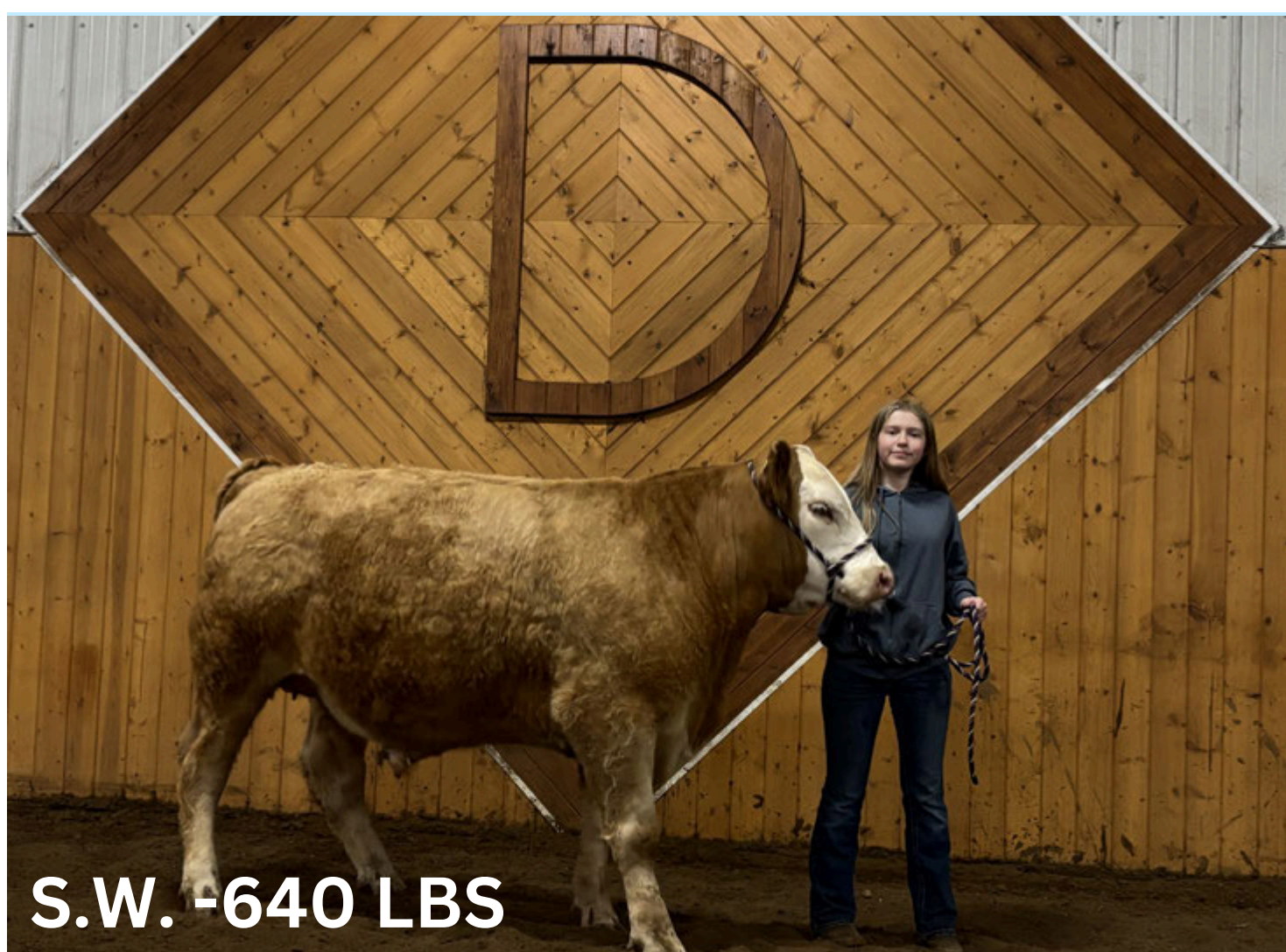
Interests: Horses, Farming, Art, Crafts, Intarsia, and Being Outside.

I am an Intermediate Member and this is my 4th year in 4-H. This year my projects are Market Steer and Breeding Heifer.

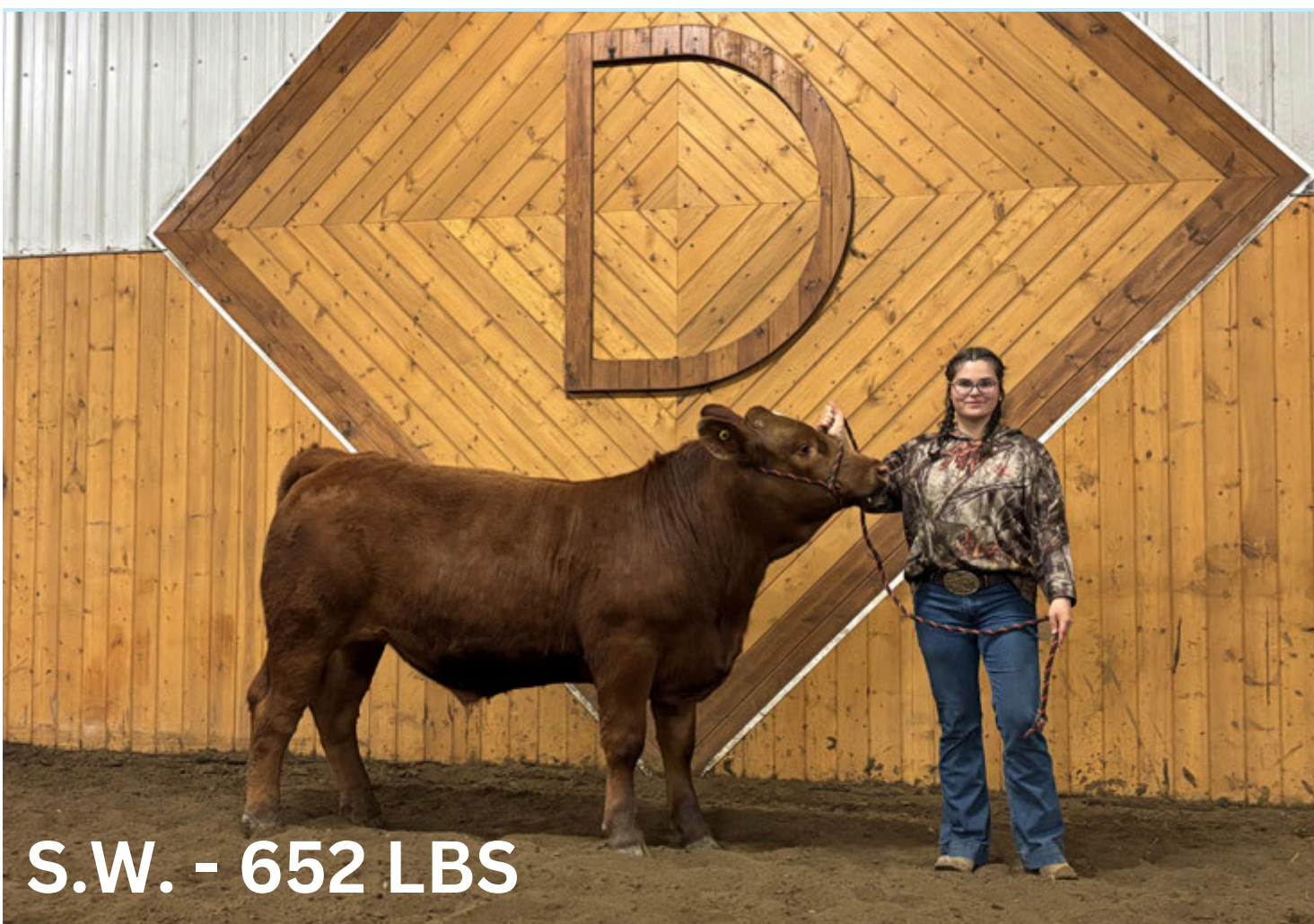
Interests: Hunting, Fishing, MMA, Watching Wrestling, and Animals.
