# Craft Project



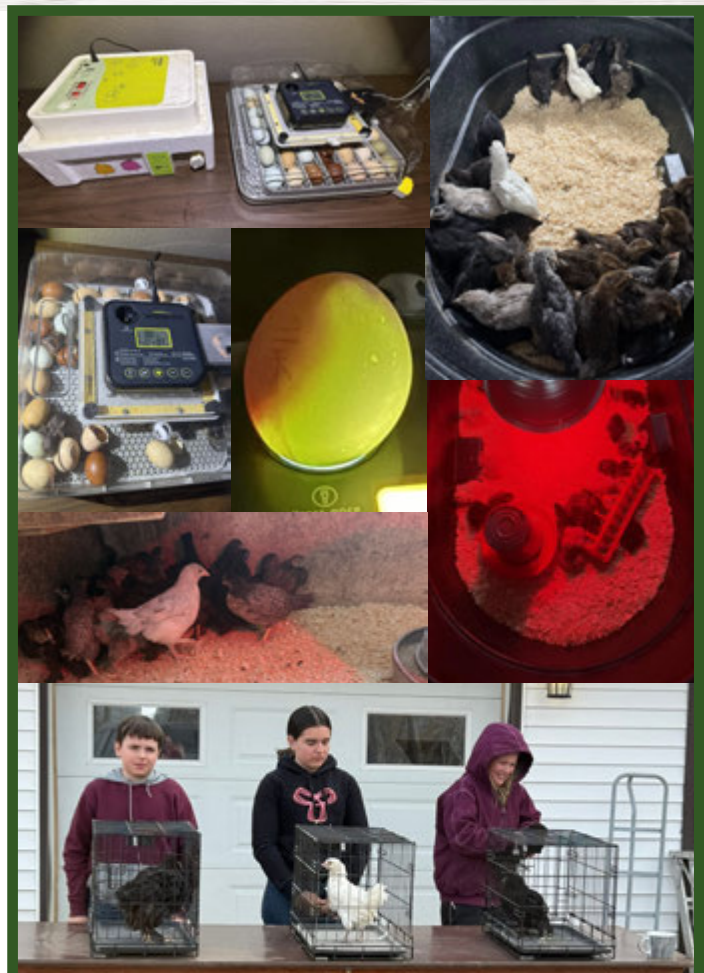
