At the time of sale, transportation date and method will be discussed. If you leave the bull at the farm following the sale we strongly encourage that you insure the bull for the full purchase price.

## Sight Unseen



**FROM GLENWOOD:** ½ mile east, 1 mile north and 3 miles east. Off Highway 810, turn east on Twp Rd 52, we are 3 miles east at the end of the road.

**FROM CALGARY:** Hwy 2 south to exit 194B (Hwy 3 -

Crowsnest Pass), west on Hwy 3 for a mile, turn left on Hwy 810 towards Glenwood, stay on Hwy 810 for about 40 km., after you cross the Waterton River you'll travel about 3.5 miles and then turn left on Township Road 52. Travel 3 miles east, we are at the end of the road.

In 2024 we were in need of a heifer bull. 3102L was in our bull pen and had great CE and BW numbers.
