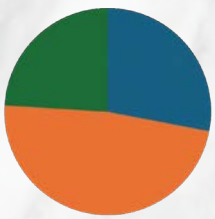

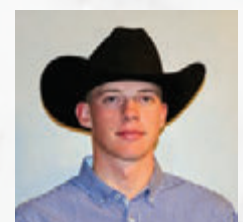

The Growth Fund progeny consistently posts average daily gains above average. We had 9 Growth Fund bull calves born in 2025. 8 of the 9 are in our Triple A offering. The 9th missed the October trip to Hagerty's for the winter feeding. He was one of the first bulls to sell off the farm. The Growth Fund daughters are making awesome momma cows as well.

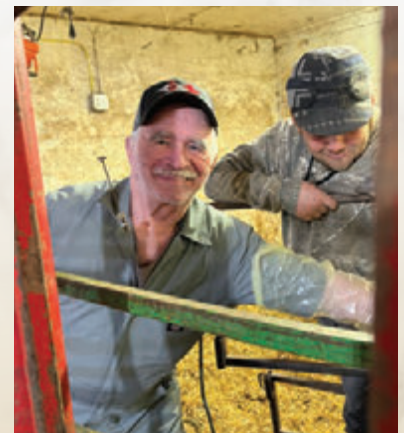

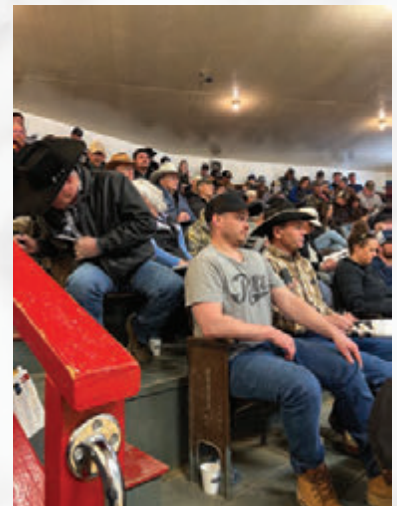
